Children will be allocated to a Kindergarten class where they will participate in activities they would experience at the beginning of the Kindergarten year e.g. morning routine, singing, shared reading, developmental play and art. Students should line up at 9.30am in the assembly area with this class.

We encourage you to leave your child/children with the teachers during each of the transition sessions as it will help them to settle into the routine of coming to school.

**YOUR CHILD WILL NEED TO:**

Wear comfortable play clothes  
Bring a change of clothes (in case of accidents)

Please ensure you collect your child at 10.15am as the Kindergarten teachers need to return to their regular teaching programs.

If you are unable to pick up your child by 10.15am, please make alternative arrangements. Have a friend or relative collect your child and please do let the teachers know prior to this happening.

Please Remember:

- To put your child's name on all belongings – clothing, hats, bag or back pack.
- In case of emergencies, the school phone number is 9724 3470.
- To prepare your child for saying good-bye.
- If your child is upset, please stay until they are settled.
- Pack spare clothing in your child's bag for 'little accidents' – underpants, shorts/trousers, socks.
