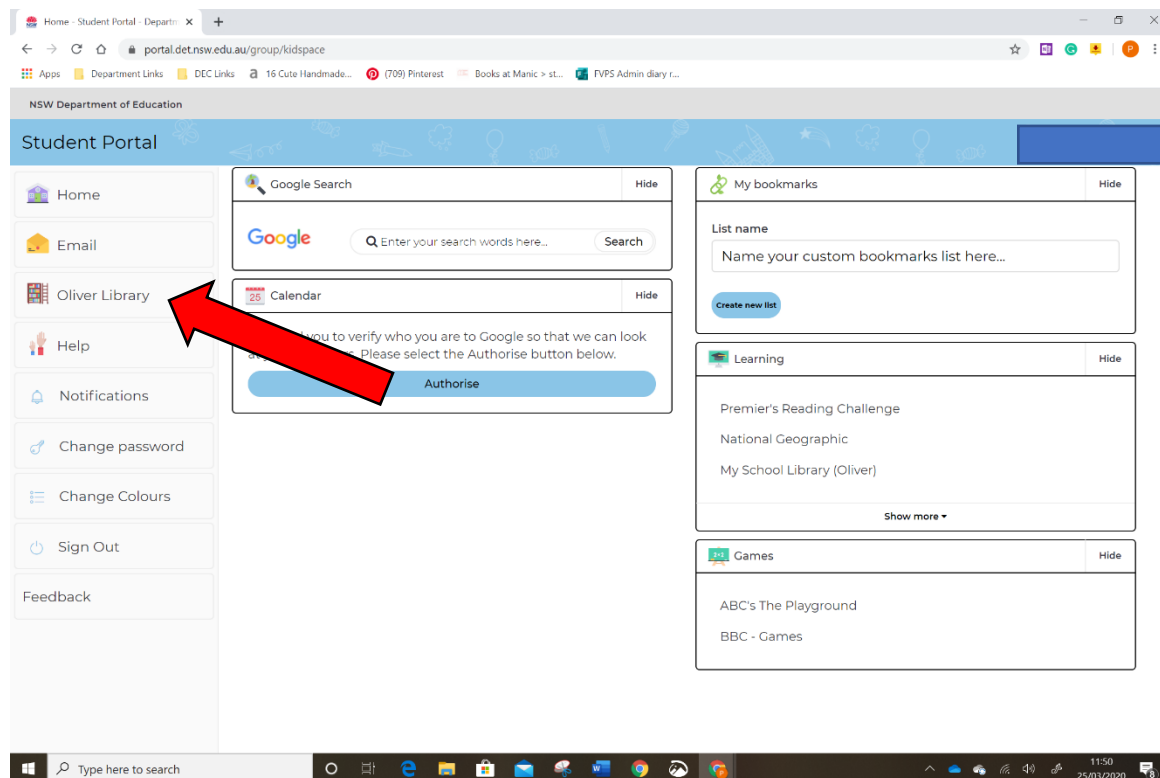

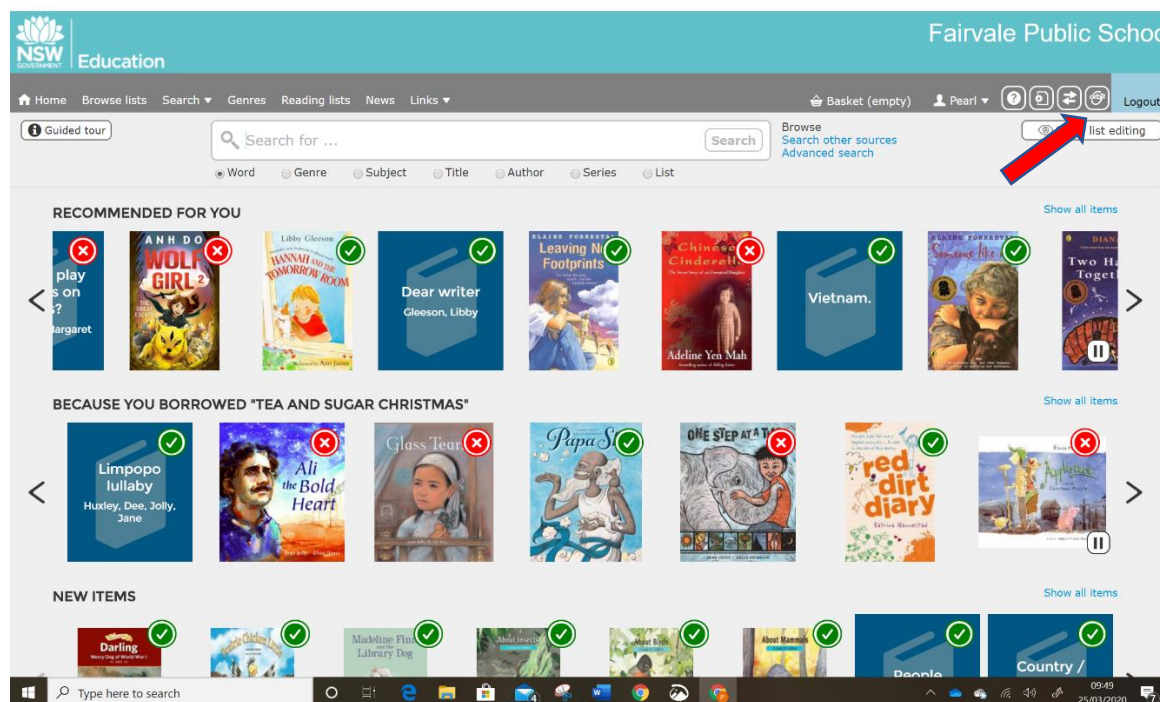

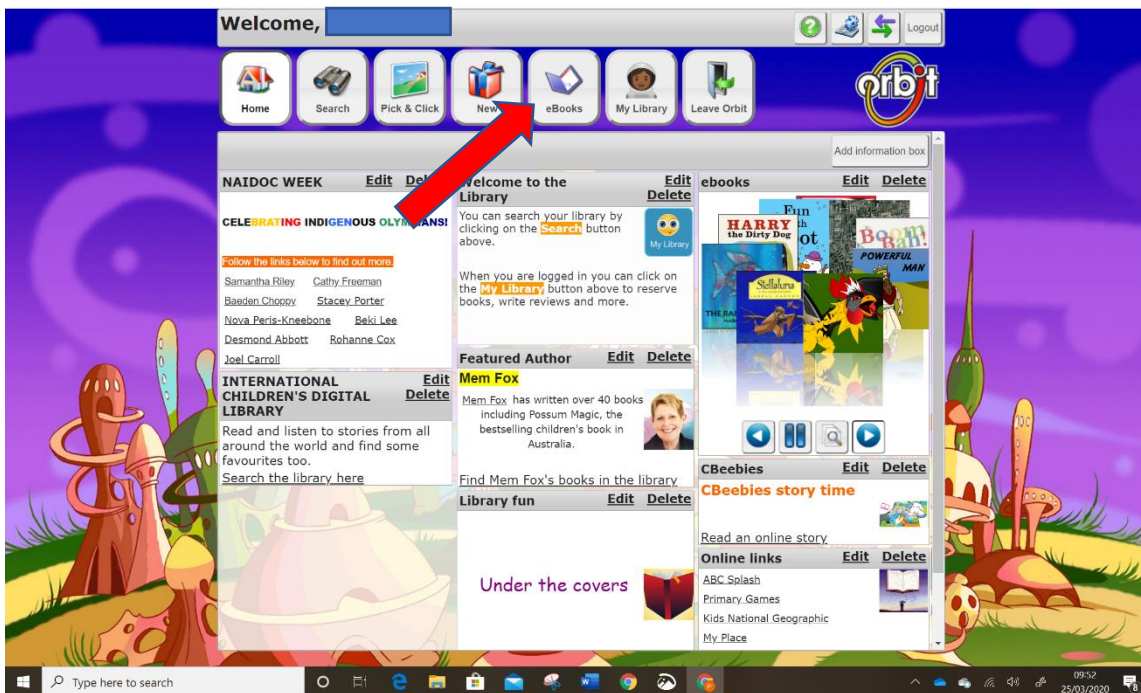
Logon to your student portal with your DEC username and password

Go to **Orbit**





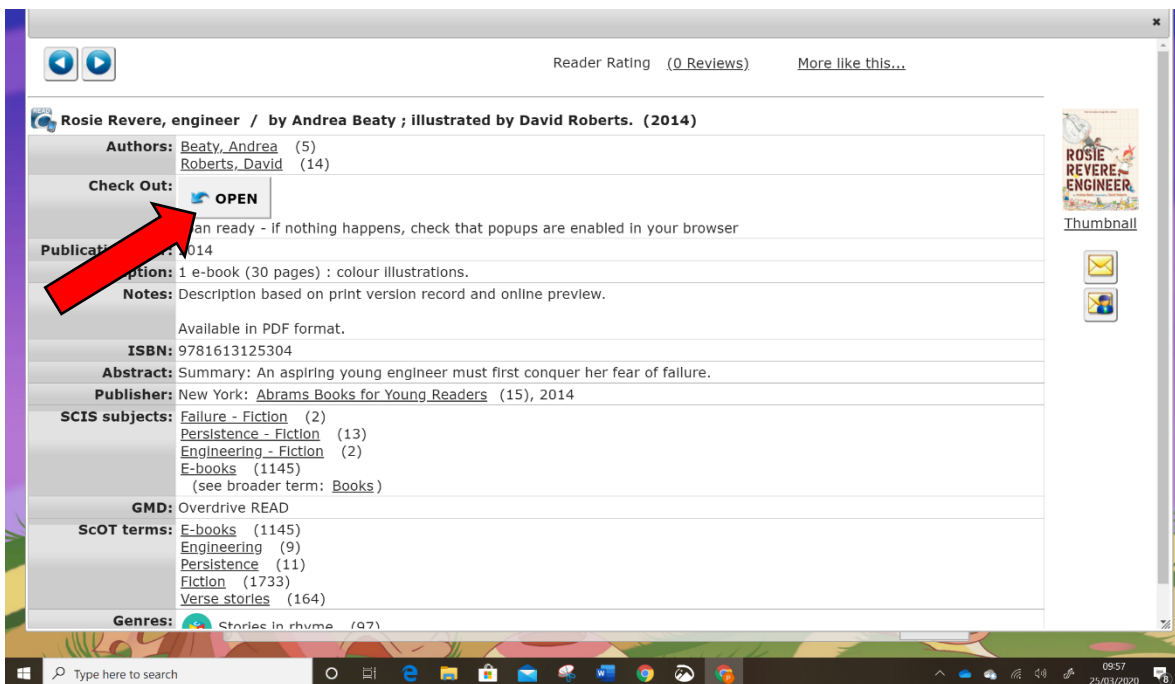
- Scroll through the eBooks to find the one you would like to read

- and the green tick to let you know that it's in 



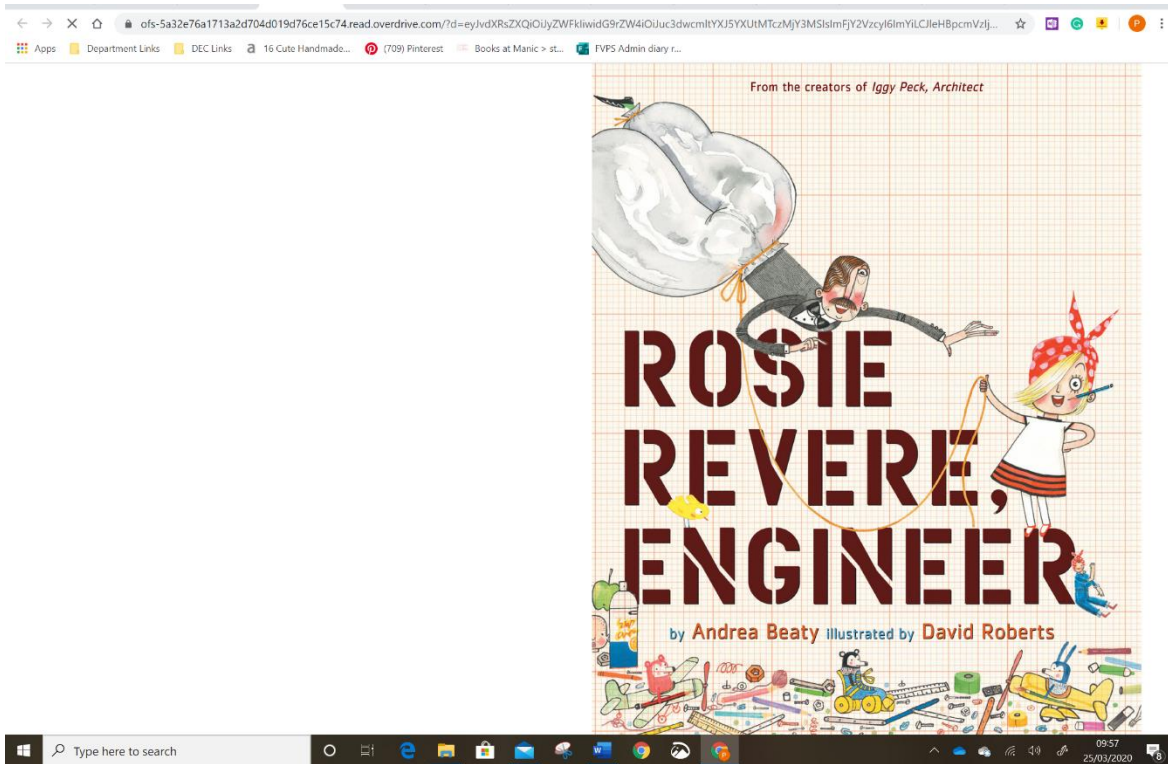
Click on the title of the eBook you want to read



Click **OPEN** to read your book

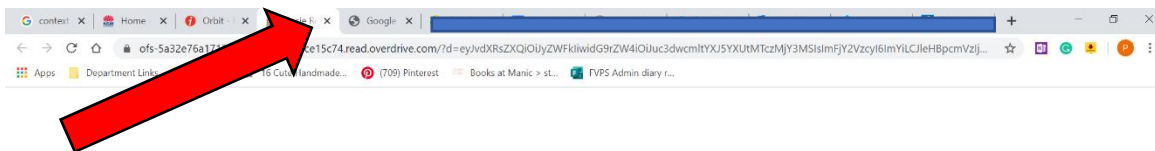


Your eBook will open in a new tab. Click on the far-right side of the book to turn the pages forward, and on the left far side to turn pages back.
