<p>About our Aboriginal Person</p>  <p>Linda Burney</p>	<p>Linda Burney is an Australian Politician. She is a member of the Wiradjuri nation and was the first Aboriginal person to be elected into the NSW Parliament and the first Aboriginal woman to serve in the Australian House of Representatives. Linda's commitment to Indigenous issues spans more than 30 years.</p>
<p>Homework/ Home Readers</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Homework is given out weekly on Mondays and is due every Friday. Homework is placed in a black folder and consists of both literacy and numeracy parts. Students are also encouraged to log on and complete activities on both Reading Eggs and Mathletics. • Home Readers come in a clear folder and children will need to return their Home Reading Folder each day so that they can change their book for a new one. If children do not have their folder they will not be able to borrow a new book. Children are encouraged to read their home reader every night.
<p>Library, Music and Fitness</p>	<p>Students will participate in weekly rotation of Library, Music and fitness. They will need to ensure they bring their Library bag every Tuesday.</p>
<p>Your child's resources</p>	<p>The following resources are needed for your child's learning:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Paint shirt • Library bag (students need to bring a bag to carry their books after borrowing from the Library- Students will not be able to borrow if they do not have a library bag). • Headphones (students will use these on the computers during reading groups). • School Hat <p><u>Please ensure all resources are labelled clearly with your child's class and name.</u></p>
<p>Seesaw</p>	<p>Parents can access seesaw to see all the learning your child does during school. More information on this can be found on the sheet provided in your child's homework folder.</p>
<p>Absences</p>	<p>If your child is away for any reason a note needs to be provided explaining why they are absent. If your child is absent for more than 3 days a medical certificate will need to be provided. If no note is returned the teacher will send home an absent note with the child.</p>
