




# Welcome to 3 Denmark

Dear Parents, Carers and students,

<b>About our Country</b> 	<p>This year, classes have been named after countries competing in the 2020 Olympics in Tokyo. Our class is named after North European country Denmark. According to the World Happiness Report, Denmark is the happiest country in the world. Their national sport is football (soccer).</p>
<b>Homework, Mathletics and Reading Eggs</b> 	<p>Homework is given on a fortnightly basis. Students have 2 weeks to complete the activities and return it on Friday (Odd weeks - 5, 7, 9, 11 for Term 1. Even weeks - 2, 4, 6, 8, 10 for Term 2, 3 and 4). I encourage you to come and see me if completing homework is causing any difficulty. Students can access Reading Eggs and Mathletics at home. Their logins will be in their homework folders.</p>
<b>Library, Music, Drama, Health and PDHPE</b>	<p>On Mondays during odd weeks, 3D will have Mrs Olivera and Mrs Orwin for library and music (students are encouraged to bring a library bag in order to borrow). Mondays during even weeks, students will have Miss Berry and Ms Marcus for drama, health and PDHPE.</p>
<b>School Banking</b>	<p>School banking is on every Thursday.</p>
<b>Your child's resources</b>	<p>Students will need:            Library - library bag*            Art - paint shirt*            Literacy groups - Headphones*            Sport - school hat*            *all equipment must be labelled with the students name and class, e.g. "Jack 3D"  <b>Thank you to all who have supplied tissues, wet wipes and hand soap for use in the classroom. Further donations would be appreciated as we will be needing them throughout the year.</b></p>
<b>Seesaw</b> 	<p>Every student in 3D has an account with Seesaw. Each student has their own personal log in and I encourage families to follow along with their child's portfolio. If you lose your access sheet, please don't hesitate to ask for another. Students will be uploading work samples, photos, videos and sharing their learning journey throughout 2020 with you via this app. This will also be a place where I will share important class information and reminders, when necessary. Should you require help logging in and using Seesaw, please do not hesitate to come and see me.</p>
<b>Absences</b>	<p>If your child is absent for 1-2 days, you need to bring a note or verbally explain to me why your child wasn't able to come to school. If it's 3 or more days, a doctor's certificate is required to explain the absence period. Any holidays or extended leave must be approved by the principal.</p>
<b>Permission Notes</b>	<p>Permission notes need to be given to me or the office before their due date. All money for various events and excursions should go to the office.</p>
