









# Kindergarten Oman 2020

Dear Parents and Carers, my name is Miss Olivia Boog and I am the classroom teacher of KO. I look forward to seeing what the year will bring for Kindergarten. This year our classes at Fairvale are named after countries competing in the 2020 Tokyo Olympics. Oman is a country located in Southwest Asia and is one of the countries competing in the 2020 Olympics.

Below you will find specific information regarding your child's learning and class this year. I look forward to teaching your children this year.

<p><u><b>Attendance</b></u></p> 	<p>It is very important that all students attend school every day, but we understand if your child is sick or there is an emergency. However, it is essential for children in their first year of schooling to attend school as much as possible. We do many important activities that will benefit students through the rest of their schooling. If your child is away please ensure you either call the office to inform us or send a note with your child on the next day that they are at school. This note needs to be returned within 7 days of the absence.</p>
<p><u><b>Concerns</b></u></p> 	<p>If you ever have any concerns regarding your child whether that be academic or not, please feel free to come and see me. I will endeavour to solve your concern or provide you with the information you need.</p>
<p><u><b>Reading Eggs and Mathletics</b></u></p> 	<p>We are lucky enough to have access to both Reading Eggs, for English and Mathletics, for Mathematics. I will provide each student with a log on for each program. We will do some of these activities at school however, if you would work with your child at home that would be extremely helpful.</p>
<p><u><b>Names on belongings</b></u></p> 	<p>Please ensure all of your child's belongings have their names on them. We often have hats and jumpers without names on them and they go missing. Please make sure that you label everything clearly with your child's name and class.</p>
<p><u><b>Home Reading</b></u></p> 	<p>Each week we will send books home with students in a clear plastic folder. Books will need to be returned every Monday/Wednesday and Friday. Please ensure that you return the books on these days so we can swap the books. <b>If children do not have their folder they will not be able to borrow a new book.</b> Children are encouraged to read their home reader every night.</p>
<p><u><b>Sports clothes on Friday</b></u></p> 	<p>It is our sport day on Fridays so please ensure that your child is wearing their sports uniform. This will include white joggers for them to run in.</p>
<p><u><b>Notes Home</b></u></p> 	<p>I will send all notes home inside your child's bag. Please check this regularly. This will also include our school newsletter which is sent home every fortnight.</p>
<p><u><b>Seesaw</b></u></p> 	<p>We will be sharing our learning in KO through the use of Seesaw. I will provide you with the login which you can simply download on your phone. You will be able to see pictures of learning, work samples and special events.</p>
