MULTICULTURAL DAY CELEBRATIONS



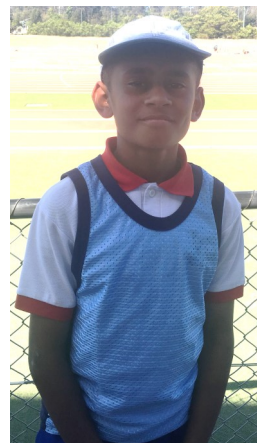

A special mention to Thomas Koro who will be representing Fairvale Public school at the next level.

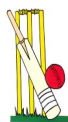


Thomas Koro finished 1st in the boys Junior 800m and 1st in the boys Junior 1500m.
