








From the Principal



ROCKETING AROUND THE SCHOOL WITH MR PITT

This week I visited our Kindergarten and Stage 2 EAL/D groups. EAL/D stands for English as an Additional Language and/or Dialect. Many of our students come from an EAL/D background and our school has specialist teachers employed to work with EAL/D students across the school.



KINDER EAL/D: On Tuesday I visited Kinder EAL/D class with Mrs Tsioras. The children have been learning about living and non-living things. This smaller group learning provided the children with an opportunity to focus on strong talk linked to vocabulary. It was pleasing listening to each child complete various tasks. It is evident that they have all improved so much since commencing school.

STAGE 2 EAL/D : Last week I visited two sessions of Stage 2 EAL/D with Mrs Sutarov and Miss Michael. Children have been learning about sea-life and used their knowledge of the recent aquarium excursion to talk about their new knowledge. The children participated in a fun role play activity focusing on asking and answering questions. Children also used the correct vocabulary to label a shark. After this we sang a fun shark song and then played shark-tooth bingo.
