Years 3-6 Swimming Carnival

Dear Parents/Carers

Fairvale Public School will be holding a Year 3-6 Swimming Carnival on **Monday 24th February 2020**. This carnival will be suitable for swimmers and non-swimmers, as there will be rotating fun activities for all students. Those children who are competent swimmers may participate in the races to qualify for the Zone Swimming Carnival. **Students who are in Year 2 and who are 8 years old this year, are also invited to attend the carnival, provided they can swim 50m of the pool unassisted.**

WHERE: Fairfield Leisure Centre

WHEN: Monday 24th February, 2020

COST: **\$10.00** (this will cover pool hire and pool entry)

TRAVEL: Bus

TIME: All children **must be at school by 8:15** to travel to the pool




WHAT TO BRING: Students are asked to wear their **swimming costume** to school under their uniform. Bring a **change of clothes**, including underwear. Bring a **sun hat, sunscreen, a towel** and a **rash vest**. Wear **appropriate shoes** (no thongs). Bring **recess, lunch** and a **drink** (no glass bottles). Students can also bring a **blanket** to sit on as they will be sitting on grass.

Please note that this is a school event for Years 3-6. All Year 3-6 teachers and support teachers will be at the carnival, therefore no classes will take place at school on this day for students in Years 3-6.

Parents are welcome to attend the carnival but they need to make their own way to the pool and pay the nominated entry fee at the gate.

Please note that each child must have their own permission note with details that relate to their swimming ability and medical details.

Every student entering the water **MUST** wear the provided coloured wristband, which identifies his or her swimming ability. **Ensure you read and fill out the attached permission note correctly and return it to school, with payment to the office by Thursday 20th February.** Students will be issued with their wristbands on the day of the carnival.


