<p><b><u>Attendance</u></b></p> 	<p>It is very important that students attend school every day unless they are sick. If your child is away, please call the office to inform the school or send a note with your child on the next day that they are at school. This note needs to be returned within 7 days of the absence.</p>
<p><b><u>Concerns</u></b></p> 	<p>If you ever have any concerns regarding your child, please do not hesitate to contact me. I will endeavour to address your concern or provide you with the information you need. You can schedule a phone call through the office or message me on Seesaw.</p>
<p><b><u>Reading Eggs and Mathletics</u></b></p> 	<p>We are lucky enough to have access to both Reading Eggs, for English and Mathletics, for Mathematics. Students have been provided their Reading Eggs and Mathletics log in and passwords to use. We will complete activities at school however, students will be able to access these programs at home.</p>
<p><b><u>Homework</u></b></p> 	<p>Homework is given on a fortnightly basis. These activities are set for students to revise the content they have learnt at school. It is encouraged that students complete most activities independently. Homework is due on Fridays on even weeks (week 2, 4, 6, 8 and 10).</p>
<p><b><u>Reading</u></b></p> 	<p>Students are encouraged to read every night for 20 minutes. This can be a book they have borrowed from the library.</p>
<p><b><u>Sports clothes on Friday</u></b></p> 	<p>It is our sport day on Fridays so please ensure that your child is wearing their sports uniform. This includes comfortable joggers for them to run in.</p>
<p><b><u>Notes Home</u></b></p> 	<p>Notes are sent home with your child. Please check this regularly. We are a very busy school and we often send notes home with important information.</p>
<p><b><u>Resources</u></b></p> 	<p>Please ensure that your child has headphones, an art shirt and a school hat. These items can be kept in your child's school bag or in the classroom.</p>
<p><b><u>Names on belongings</u></b></p>	<p>Please ensure all of your child's belongings have their names on them.</p>
<p><b><u>Seesaw</u></b></p> 	<p>We will be sharing our learning in 2/3C using Seesaw. Each child will have their own portfolio which you can view on your device. You will be able to see pictures of learning, work samples and special school events.</p>
