I will provide each student with a log in for each program. We will do some of these activities at school however, if you would work with your child at home that would be extremely helpful.
<u>Names on</u> <u>belongings</u>	Please ensure all your child's belongings have their names on them. We often have hats and jumpers without names on them and they go missing. With winter coming up please make sure that you label everything!
<u>Sports clothes on</u> <u>Friday</u>	It is our sport day on Fridays so please ensure that your child is wearing their sports uniform. This will include white joggers for them to run in. PSSA is hopefully going to resume in 2022 for students in Years 3-6, so some students will have the opportunity to compete against other schools and represent Fairvale!
Notes	I will send all notes home inside your child's bag. Please check this regularly, we are a very busy school, and we will often send notes home with important information. This will also include our school newsletter which is sent home every fortnight.
<u>RFF</u>	On Tuesday this year, students will be participating in library, music and creative arts. Please encourage your children to borrow a book from the library and read their borrowed book at home. A library bag is needed to borrow a book
<u>Seesaw</u> FAMILY	We will be sharing our learning in 4/5E using Seesaw. Each child will have their own account which you can simply download on your phone if you have already not connected. You will be able to see pictures of learning, work samples and special events. I will contact you regularly through Seesaw so please check often.
